### Introduction/Background Information

Americana Chinese International School first opened to students in August 2019 by the school's fonder, Ms Amporn, as the latest addition to her education group, The Ambassador Group. The school took over a campus that was initially used for Unity Concord International School. At the time of opening, the school was only accommodating for Grades K-8 and has since grown to include all grades until Grade 11, and will be introducing Grade 12 next academic year.

### Reason for Substantive Change Visit

ACIS has grown substantially over recent years and has now expanded to include K1 to Grade 12, International School. Since the school's initial opening they have added grades 8,9, and grade 10 was added for the 2024-2025 school year. To accommodate such large growth, and to accommodate the 500+ students that are now on campus, there was an addition of 2 new buildings- Building B and Building C. The completion of building C was most recent and opened for students in October 2024.

### Substantive Change Visit Findings

TH School provided a simple substantive change report listing the reasons for change as being to accommodate the growing student population. During the visit, the VC had the opportunity to speak with various stakeholders. The VC

found the facilities to be appropriate and well maintained. The school is well positioned for growth in enrollment, which has been rising rapidly in recent years. Building C is a modern and well thought out building with facilities that will support both student numbers and school programming in the future. The Building C includes facilities such as a large auditorium/shared canteen area, a large multipurpose gym used for both PE and external competitions. In terms of safeguarding, the buildings have clearly labeled student and adult bathrooms, there are emergency procedures in place and visibility is clear in all areas.

In general, the VC confirms that the addition of Buildings B and C are in line with expectations of WASC.
